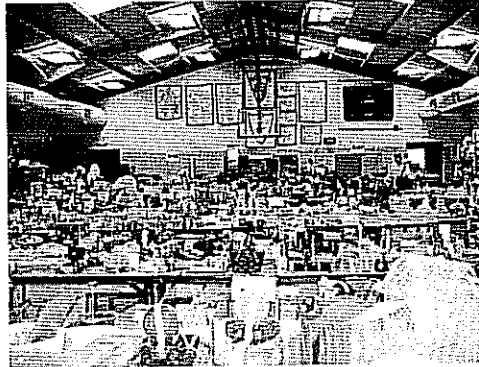

Also, we cannot accept large TV consoles, pianos/organs, large appliances, knives/weapons of any kind, tires, or car seats (due to safety concerns).

You can call us in advance or just simply show up at a drop-off! Work as many hours as you like, and children are welcome to accompany their parents. Complimentary babysitting is provided by older SJA students. Snacks/drinks are provided. Volunteers who work a minimum of 20 hours during the Flea Market season are eligible to purchase drink badges for use during Homecoming weekend.
